

**SECURITY COMMITTEE – PERMANENT CEASEFIRE AND TRANSITIONAL SECURITY ARRANGEMENTS
 AGREED PRINCIPLES (WORKING DRAFT) (Draft Version 3 – 20 December 2014)**

Purpose:

- To establish a baseline of party agreements and disagreements, and adviser recommended options, for the components of a permanent ceasefire and transitional security arrangements (PC & TSA) (in accordance with single negotiating texts and the 4th November Summary of Agreements and Disagreements)
- To provide the basis for the drafting on an agreement relating to a permanent ceasefire and transitional security arrangements
- To act as a working draft, updated periodically as negotiations progress
